National Novel Writing Month **Read, listen, debate on the Frankfurt Book Fair**

Going digital is paramount not only for the entire business around books, but more and more readers and writers are moving online. Additional to conventional media, contents are increasingly available in fast spreading innovative ways.

Various digital topics are dealt with in many events on the Frankfurt Book Fair running from 10th to 14th October. Many of them are addressing the general public as well as trade visitors. The Forum Innovation in Hall 4.2 hosts events around Podcasts and virtual worlds like "Second Life".

Participants of last year's "National Novel Writing Month", aka NaNoWriMo (nanowrimo.org), will share their experiences on Sunday, 14th October in Hall 4.2 P421. They'll show how one can write a novel in 30 days with digital help of a growing world wide online community with more than 80.000 registered authors in 2006.

The event is supported by the German base (nanowrimo.de) of authors who will embark on the world wide challenge on 1st November 2007 when "National Novel Writing Month" starts again.

Another meeting point for those interested in Podcasts and Blogs is the Web 2.0 Living Room (Hall 4.2 Q411), where the making of the Fair's Podcasts and Blogs can be viewed live.
